Lincoln Park Zoo is renowned for its exceptional breeding success with gorillas and for its dedication to great ape research and conservation. In 1976, the Lester E. Fisher Great Ape House was built as a state-of-the-art home for the zoo's gorilla and chimpanzee groups. 25 years later, the zoo wanted to take advantage of the evolution in exhibit design and construction technology. The new exhibit provides the apes with richly textured and naturalistic enclosures. Researchers are able to observe animal behavior, and the exhibit provides for an innovative education experience for visitors to enjoy a wholly new perspective of ape life.
