Railroad and Heritage Museum Temple, TX

The Railroad and Heritage Museum is located in Temple, TX in the city's historic Santa Fe Depot.

Part of the Museum's collection is an impressive array of actual rolling stock, the center piece of which is ATSF-3423, a steam locomotive built by Baldwin in 1921 for the Santa Fe Railway.

This venerable steam locomotive worked many routes across the US, and spent much time servicing the central Texas line until 1952. She was kept at the ready for several years, just in case the newfangled diesel equipment was not up to the job.
